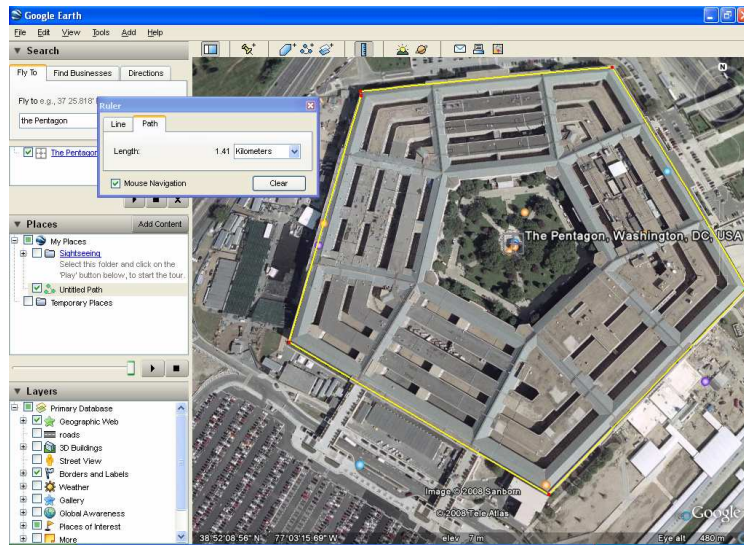


Year 4 Maths and ICT

We have discovered that the building is made of 12 regular pentagons and lots of other shapes including rectangles and kites. We were able to measure the perimeter of all these shapes. Did you know that the perimeter of the main Pentagon building is approximately 1.4 km?



We have also been investigating the patterns in the numbers on runways around the world. Did you know that the difference between the numbers at either end of any runway around the world is always 18?
