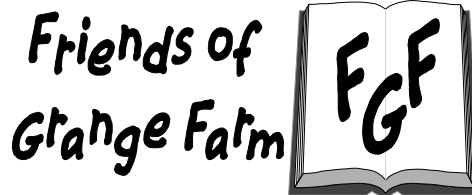

It is also worth noting that there are no

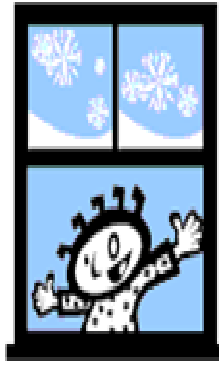

Safe School Parking

Concern has been expressed at the way in which some parents are parking outside school.
